



Arizona Science Olympiad Tournaments

Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability

*Instructions: To be completed by a parent/guardian and returned to the students Science Olympiad Head Coach. Head Coaches, please ensure all forms are properly executed and **submit with your Team Registration. Deadline to submit is January 15, 2025.***

Arizona Science Olympiad will offer tournaments in the following formats. Awards ceremonies for Satellite and Hub tournaments will be held virtually during which the student first name, first initial of last name and school will be presented (e.g., Michael S., Tucson H.S.). Awards ceremonies at a Gold Tournament will be held in person.

Satellite: In a Satellite tournament, students are competing at their own school under the direction of their Head Coach. Some tests will be provided on-line via the Competition Platform and others will be administered in the classroom/school grounds. Some events may require a video submission or communication with the Event Supervisor via Zoom. COVID measures are defined by their school.

Hub: In a Hub tournament, students in technology, physics, chemistry, and some inquiry events may compete at a host site. Any remaining events will take place via the Competition Platform over a period of one to three days. Some events may require a video submission or communication with the Event Supervisor via Zoom. COVID measures may include limiting student attendance, social distancing, and the recommendation of mask usage.

Gold: The Gold standard tournament is an in-person tournament where students interact with their teammates, other teams, tournament officials, and host site personnel. COVID measures may include limiting teams, limiting guests, social distancing, and wearing masks.

Assumption of Risk

I, Parent/Guardian understand and acknowledge that my child's and/or my participation and/or entrance to the event and related areas may involve serious risks, including but not limited to risk of personal injury, or property damage and acknowledge that he/she is voluntarily participating in this activity and agree to assume any such risks for any injury, death or damage to or loss of personal property arising out of, or in connection with participation in the activity from whatever cause, including any other participants in the activity.

Release of Liability

In consideration of my child's and/or my participation in the activity, I, Parent/Guardian, waive all claims or causes of action against tournaments sponsored by Arizona Science Olympiad, Arizona Science Olympiad, and Science Olympiad, Inc., its auxiliary organizations, and the officers, directors, employees, and agents of all of them arising out of his/her participation.

Use of Media and Digital Content and Release of Liability

Photography Release: By confirming my attendance/participation at Arizona Science Olympiad events, I, Parent/Guardian, hereby irrevocably grant Arizona Science Olympiad, including its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, representatives, agents, successors, and assignees, perpetually, exclusively, and for use throughout the world, any and all rights to use and incorporate, in whole or in part, my child's photograph, whether it be represented in a still image or a video or film, my child's name, and likeness, for reproduction in any and all media for purposes of advertising, trade, display, exhibition, editorial; use or other use as determined by Arizona Science Olympiad in its sole discretion.
