

**Here is how to participate in the remaining Mini-Olympiads:**

Download a copy of the rules for your division. (B: 6 – 9<sup>th</sup> grade; C: 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade)

Send in a copy of your team registration form to [idahosciolygc@gmail.com](mailto:idahosciolygc@gmail.com) if not already done.

Prepare for your event by studying and researching links on [www.soinc.org](http://www.soinc.org) and elsewhere.

| **Send an email to the listed event supervisor** with your email address(es) for the test and links.  
Each event has the initials of that event's Supervisor.

**On the day of a Mini-Olympiad event, you (and your colleagues) will receive:**

An email copy of the test prior to the scheduled time. (Do not open until told to do so).

A link to the Zoom link for the test. (You may ask questions for clarification as needed)

An answer sheet (at the completion of the test) for you to score your own answers.

**During the test you:**

May ask questions of the event supervisor (via Zoom) (She/He may respond: "I can't say").

May consult with any other members of your team by email or phone, etc.

May consult any of your own notes, books, study materials.

May consult internet sources, but that will most likely be a waste of valuable time.

MAY NOT use your coaches, teachers or parents as sources.

May see a video, description, or image from the Event Supervisor (Via Zoom) as part of the test.

**At the end of the period:**

You will be emailed an answer KEY to the test.

You will be asked self-grade your test using the answer KEY.

You will be asked to submit your score to the Event Supervisor to be reported anonymously.

**Here is how to participate in the State Online Competition April 24th:**

Note: Participation in the state competition does NOT require prior Mini-Olympiad participation.

Prepare for your event by studying and researching links on [www.soinc.org](http://www.soinc.org) and elsewhere.

**Send an email to the listed event supervisor** with your email address(es) for the test and links.

Each event has the initials of that event's Supervisor.

**On April 24th, log into the Zoom session.**

You may enter or leave and reenter depending upon your personal event schedule.

Depending upon your event and event supervisor, you may be assigned to a "breakout" room.

**On April 24th, you (and your colleagues) will receive:**

An email copy of the test prior to the scheduled time. (Do not open until told to do so).

The test will be in MS Word (docx) format. You will need to be able to open and edit it.

Each event lasts 45 minutes starting on the hour.

**During the test you:**

May ask questions of the event supervisor (via Zoom) (She/He may respond: "I can't say").

May consult with any other members of your team by email or phone, etc.

May consult any of your own notes, books, study materials.

May consult internet sources, but that will most likely be a waste of valuable time.

MAY NOT use your coaches, teachers or parents as sources.

May see a video, description, or image from the Event Supervisor (Via Zoom) as part of the test.

**At the end of each scheduled event period :**

Competitors can send up to two edited copies of their test prior to the end of the hour.

Completed files should be sent to the event supervisor (Super) for that event.

Note that there is a 15 min. grace period after the 45 minutes to submit your edited .docx file.

If two edited copies are sent for a team, DO NOT have conflicting answers for a question.

**On April 24th, from 4:00 – 5:00 PM Winners of each event will be announced.**

Teams and team members will be awarded medals and trophies.

Medals and Trophies will be delivered to coaches for distribution to teams.

The top teams of both B and C Divisions will be the Idaho teams for the National Competition.
