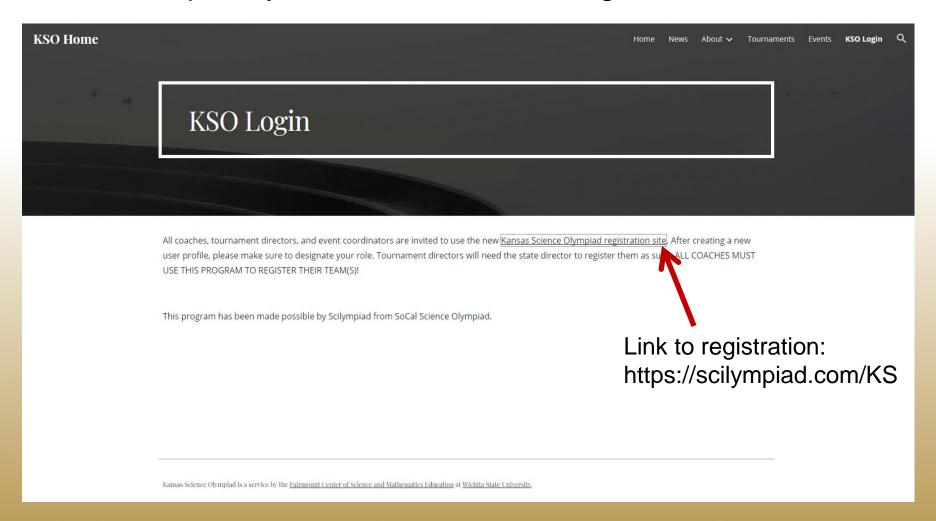






Registering a school





KSO Registration – Adding a Team


Registering a team

Registering a team (required to complete registration)




Reminder: additional teams are only allowed to compete at Invitational Tournaments.

Find the "Registration Fees" on the Head Coach Dashboard




Must click on one of the codes (most likely the "None"), but it will let you cancel any pending charges if you need to change.

KSO Registration – Continued

- Make sure you include a copy of your invoice(s)
 with your check. That is the only way of knowing
 which school's payment we have received.
- Make sure campus box 32 is included in the address. This insures that we receive the payment and not some other department on campus.
- You should have received an email upon receipt.



KSO Registration – Continued

Completing your Kansas registration automatically registers you for a regional tournament. Registration should be completed by November 8, with regional assignments made by November 15.

(Please note that in some areas of the state, the regional tournaments have been near capacity. In those cases the earlier you register, the greater the chance you will be assigned a spot in the regional of your choice.)

Regional assignments for teams registering after November 8 will be made on a case by case basis.

Last day to register is December 6, 2019.
