San Diego Science Olympiad awards team trophies to the top 6 schools in each division per tournament site or up to the number of schools advance to state, whichever number is higher. The team with the lowest overall points ranks 1st. School's placement is based on the best performing team within that school. Event awards will be given to the top 10 teams regardless of schools in each division per tournament site.

Advancement to Southern California State Science Olympiad (one team per qualifying school)

Allocation for each tournament for each Division: 3 teams + (number of teams in the division registered at that tournament / total number of teams in the division in the state).

Note: This has not impacted SD teams, but the number of teams in the division registered at the tournament includes those teams that only participate in only Invitational Tournaments due to the capacity of the tournament.
