Science Olympiad has a thriving relationship with Yale University, which hosts the popular Science Olympiad alumni-run Yale Science Olympiad Invitational Tournament. While many of our Science Olympiad teams on the East Coast have gotten to know the campus better by competing at the tournament, we'd like to take it a step further and invite students on Science Olympiad teams in a wider variety of states to consider applying for the [Yale Young Global Scholars](#) (YYGS) program. For the past five years, we have helped to expand their reach and bring more STEM-focused students to the program.

[Yale Young Global Scholars](#) is a summer academic enrichment and leadership program that brings together students from all over the world for two-week sessions on Yale's campus in New Haven or the Yale Center Beijing in China. In all YYGS sessions, students attend lectures by Yale faculty, as well as smaller seminars taught by Yale undergraduate and graduate students. Students also work in capstone project groups to identify a global problem facing the world today, conduct rigorous background research, and propose impactful solutions to their peers and instructors.
